Suggestions for making a quality video:

- 1) Most digital cameras today have the ability to capture a video. Please ensure that the video is in .mpg or .avi format.
- 2) Be mindful of background noise. Loud noises may interfere with the sound quality of the video.
- 3) Use a tripod to keep the camera steady.
